Are you interested in running for Municipal Council or School Board Trustee?

Nominations may be filed for the following positions:

- Mayor
- Regional Councillor, Wards 1 and 2
- Regional Councillor, Wards 3 and 4
- Local Councillor, Ward 1
- Local Councillor, Ward 2
- Local Councillor, Ward 3
- Local Councillor, Ward 4
- Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (3 Members)
- Peterborough Victoria Northumberland and Clarington Catholic District School Board (2 Members)
- Conseil scolaire catholique MonAvenir
- Conseil Scolaire Viamonde
- Regional Chair

The Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, prescribes that each person who intends to be a candidate in the 2022 Municipal Election must submit a nomination paper to the Municipal Clerk during regular business hours from **May 2, 2022, until 2 p.m. on August 19, 2022**. There is a \$200 filing fee for the office of Mayor and a \$100 filing fee for the office of Councillor or School Board Trustee. The filing fee must be paid when you file your nomination

paper, and the payment must be cash, debit, certified cheque, or money order made payable to "Municipality of Clarington."

If you intend to be a candidate in the 2022 Municipal Elections, you must submit your nomination paper before you are allowed to raise or spend funds for your electoral campaign. Nominations for both French School Boards are accepted at the City of Oshawa, and nominations for the Regional Chair are accepted at the Region of Durham.

Nomination papers submitted by candidates running in the 2022 Municipal Election must be endorsed by at least 25 qualified persons. The Municipal Clerk cannot accept a nomination paper with fewer than 25 signatures. A qualified person is someone who is eligible to vote if an election was to be held on the day the person endorsed the nomination paper. If you have not submitted your nomination paper, your campaign organization cannot accumulate savings or incur expenses. Also, you cannot spend your own money, or that of your spouse, before submitting your nomination form.

Voting period will take place between October 18 to October 24.
